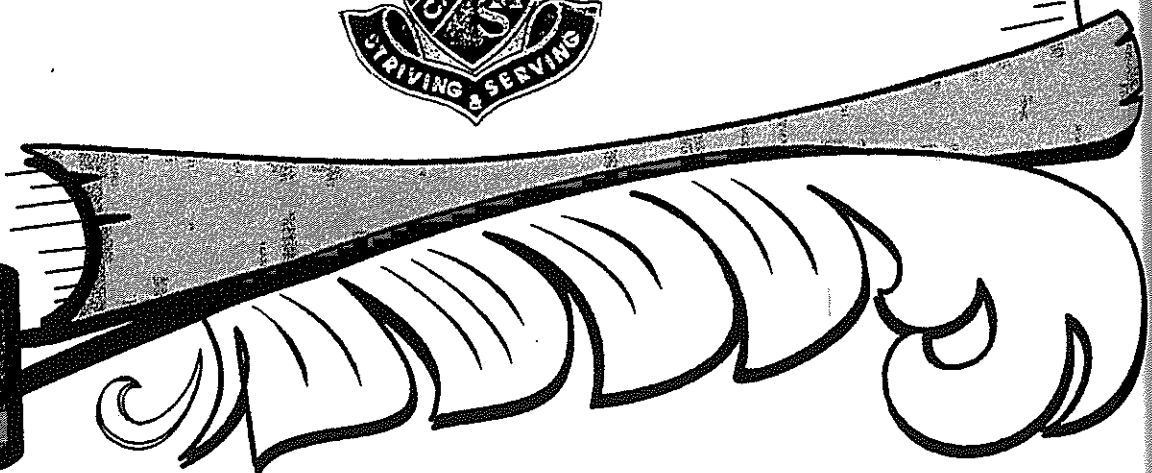
Memoirs of Cabra High

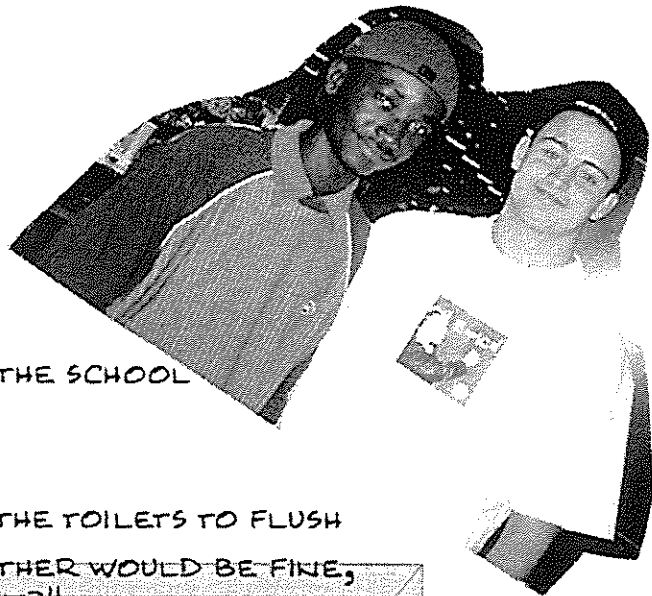
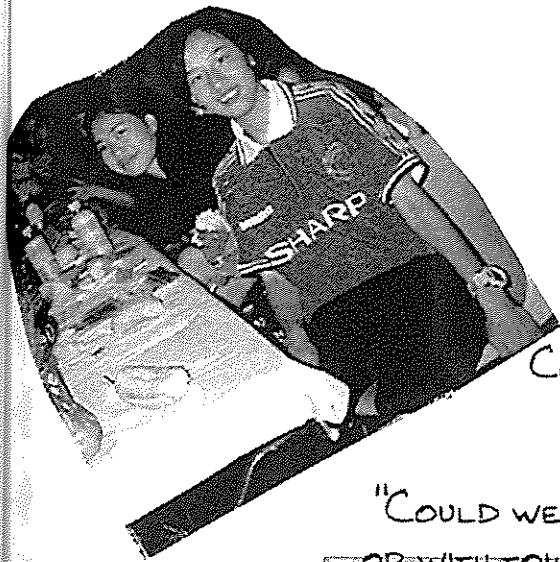
No camp is ever complete any work.

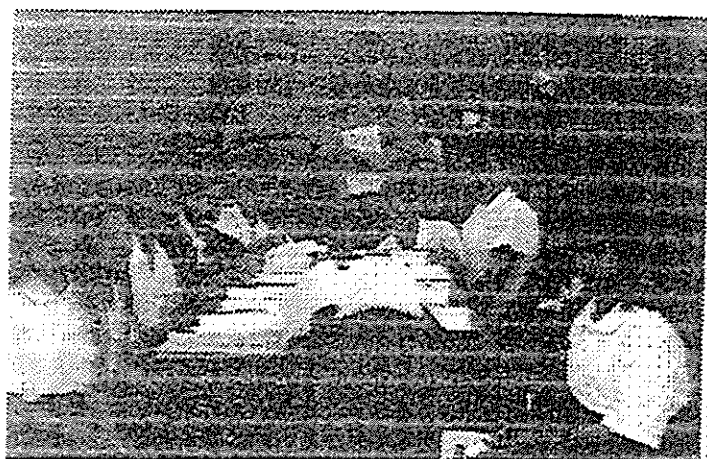
Year Seven's First Day at High School

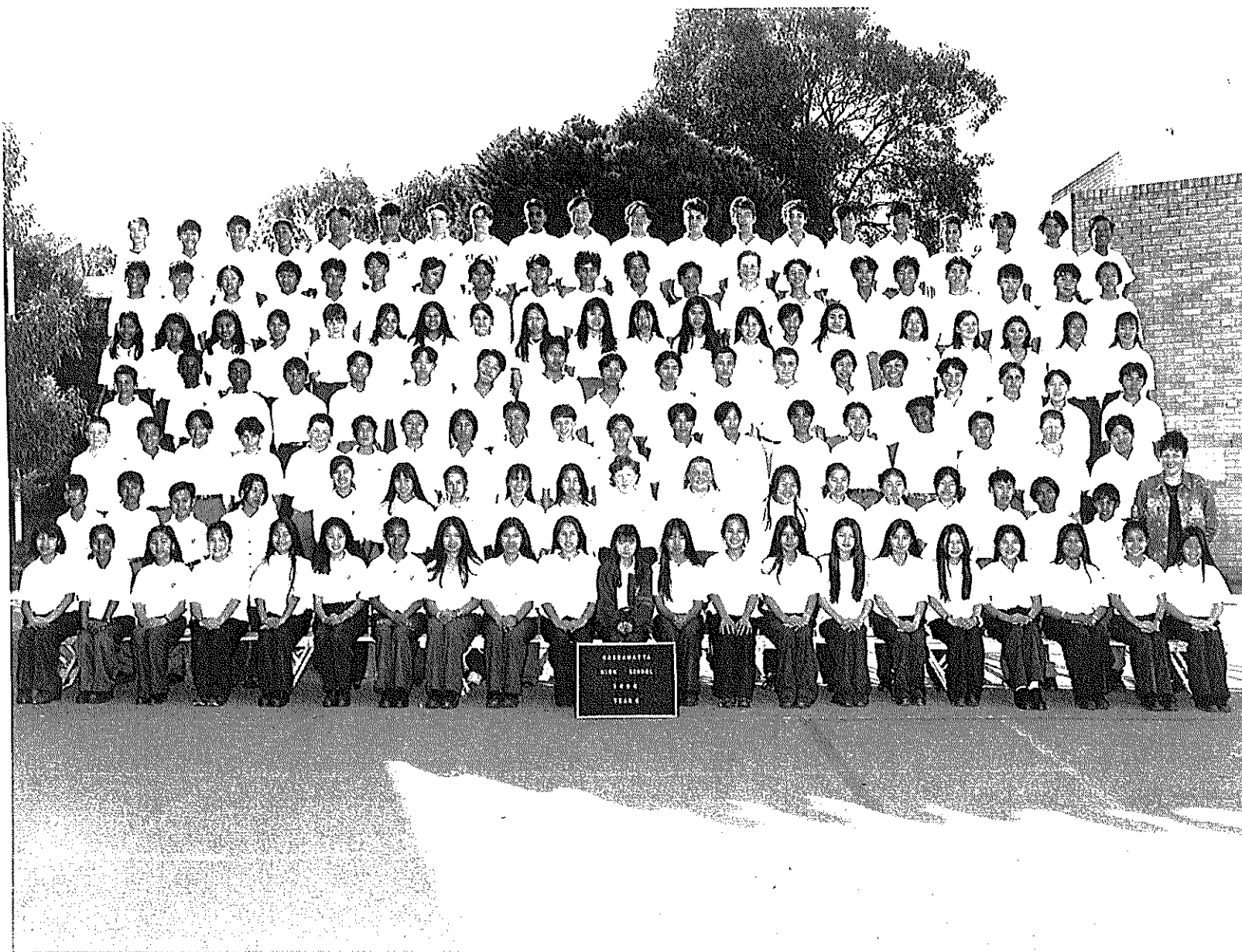
